He joined the Foreign Office in 1916 and was assistant editor of *The Times* during 1941–46.

Between January and March 1961, the historian and diplomat Edward Hallett Carr delivered a series of lectures, later published as one of the most famous historical theories of our time: *What is History?* In his lectures he advises the reader to "study the historian before you begin to study the facts", arguing that any account of the past is largely written to the agenda and social context of the one writing it.
